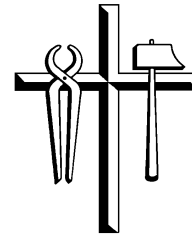

ADVANCE INFORMATION

First Holy Communion 2019

Registration Forms for the Programme will be available from first Sunday of June. They need to be completed and returned by Sunday 15th July 2018. No late admissions. Children must be at least school year 3 in September.

Secondary School Forms Children who wish to continue education in a Catholic Secondary School usually need the priest’s signature confirming that they are practising Catholics. To obtain one they need to come to church regularly and present the child’s Baptism Certificate and First Communion Certificate.

Confirmation 2019 Preparation for Confirmation will start at the beginning of September. The Registration Forms will be available from the beginning of June. Candidates need to be regular church goers and at least 14 years old in September 2018.

The R.C.I.A

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process through in which adults wishing to become Roman Catholics (or adult Roman Catholics wishing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation) are gradually introduced to the Catholic faith and way of life. The classes will start in September. Please contact Fr Edward for more details.

Sacrament of Matrimony / Convalidation of Marriage

At least six months’ notice of the date on which you hope to marry, must be given to the priest of the parish. Please contact Fr Edward for more details.

Infant/ child Baptism. At least one parent must be practicing catholic.

Children age 7 and older must accomplish a special preparation programme before baptism. Please see Fr Edward for more details.
