First Holy Communion, Confirmation, RCIA 2019. We hope to resume and complete these courses in September and have the celebrations in October.

There are no registrations for the new Courses now.

Celebration of Mass at St Peter's Dagenham (up to 70 people per Mass)

- 1. The obligation to attend Sunday Mass remains suspended. Please stay at home if you or someone you live with starts to show symptoms: a high temperature, a new, continuous cough, a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste or you have been in contact with someone who has the virus.
- 2. Children under 16 years should be accompanied by their parent or other responsible adult.
- 3. As you enter and leave the church please **sanitise your hands**. Alcohol hand gel is provided at doors. **The toilets will not be available.**
- 4. **Do not forget your face mask** or other face covering as they are compulsory as 2 metre distancing is reduced to 1 metre + from each other. Face masks/coverings must be worn by those aged 11 years and older.
- 5. Members of the same household can sit together.
- 6. There will be no singing, no offertory procession, no bidding prayers, no offertory collection and no exchanging of the sign of peace during the Mass. For donations there will be baskets available at the exits.
- 7. Holy Communion will be distributed only under one kind (i.e. the Host). You will only be able to receive Holy Communion on the hand. When you receive Holy Communion **do not say** 'Amen' aloud. It is vital that you follow the guidance of the Stewards who will direct you.
- 8. At the moment no altar servers (except of the Master of Ceremony) will be needed.
- 9. When mass has ended, please leave the church so the cleaners can begin the cleaning. Please respect the social distancing requirements before and after mass.
- 10. **(NEW)** Worshippers should limit their interactions with anyone they are not attending church with, i.e. if they are attending corporate worship with one other household, wherever possible they should maintain social distancing with anyone outside of this group.
