The Lord Jesus has revealed to his disciples the great mystery of our faith - the triune nature of God and the inseparable union of the eternal Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Jesus' mission is to reveal the glory of God to us - a Trinity of persons - God the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit - and to unite us with God in a community of love. The ultimate end, the purpose for which God created us, is the entry

of God's creatures into the perfect unity of the blessed Trinity.(...) Jesus reveals the Father in an unheard of sense. He is eternally Father by his relationship to his only Son, who, reciprocally, is Son only in relation to his Father. The Spirit, likewise, is inseparably one with the Father and the Son.

The mission of Jesus and of the Holy Spirit are the same. That is why Jesus tells his disciples that the Spirit will reveal the glory of the Father and the Son and will speak what is true. (...) In baptism we are called to share in the life of the Holy Trinity here on earth in faith and after death in eternal light.

Message from Fr Edward

As the liturgical season of Easter is now completed we returned to the Liturgical Season during the Year. The green vestments are back in use. The season starts with two important celebrations; the Sunday of the Holy Trinity (this weekend) and the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ (next Sunday).

Many books have been written about Holy Trinity but at the end of the day it remains a great mystery. St Patrick whose statue is in our church used the three leaves of a shamrock to explain the holy trinity: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. There are many people who do not need any more explanation. We express this fundamental truth of our faith whenever we bless ourselves or make the sign of the cross in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Our church remains closed however since some children returned to school and more shops are to be open, there is a hope that we may be allowed to have the church open, at least for private prayer soon. We just received some instructions on how to prepare for this.

As you can see in our newsletter there are spaces for Mass Intention. We say Masses every day.
