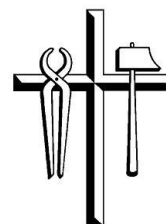

Bi-Annual Concelebrated Requiem Masses will be held at St Patrick's Cemetery on Monday 8th July at 11.30am.

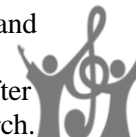
