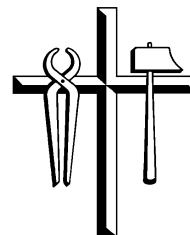

When Thomas finally had the courage to re-join the other apostles, the Lord Jesus made his presence known to him and reassured him that he had indeed overcome death and risen again. ADVANCE INFORMATION

First Holy Communion 2019

Registration Forms for the Programme will be available from first Sunday of June. They need to be completed and returned by Sunday 15th July 2018. No late admissions. Children must be at least school year 3 in September.

Secondary School Forms Children who wish to continue education in a Catholic Secondary School usually need the priest's signature confirming That they are practising Catholics. To obtain one they need to come to Church regularly and present the Baptism Certificate and First Communion Certificate.

Confirmation 2019 Preparation for Confirmation will start at the beginning of September. The Registration Forms will be available from the beginning of June. Candidates need to be regular church goers and at least 14 years old in September 2018.
