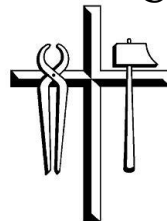

Secondary School Forms Children who wish to continue education in a Catholic Secondary School usually need the priest's signature confirming That they are practising Catholics. To obtain one they need to come to Church regularly and present Baptism and First Communion Certificates.
