**RE-OPENING OF ST PETER'S CHURCH (For private prayer only)
Monday - Saturday, 9.00am to 10.30am, from Monday 15th June.**

When visiting the church please remember that

1. The guidance only allows personal prayer which is defined as a person or household entering the church to pray on their own and not as part of a group.
- 2 Social distancing must apply at all times with people being two metres apart from one another in all directions.
3. The entry and exit will be via separate doors and some benches will be blocked off to facilitate this.
4. At least two stewards will be present in the church throughout the time it is open for prayer.
5. Alcohol hand gel will be provided at doors. Please sanitise your hands as you enter and leave the church.
6. Toilet facilities will remain closed.

We will find more details as you enter the church

We need more voluntaries to serve as stewards and help with daily cleaning of the church. Only with your help we will be able to keep the church open. We cannot accept help from those who have been advised to shield or are from groups considered more vulnerable to the virus. Volunteers who live with someone who is shielding should carefully consider the additional risk they incur.
