Message from Fr Edward.

The story of good seed and darnel draws our attention to the reality of daily life, where good and evil are present at this same time and sometimes it is very difficult to say one from the other. In some situations we need to wait up to harvest time to see if the fruits are good or useless or even poisonous. The time of pandemic teaches us how important it is to make right decision I right time and how difficult it may be.

This is a third weekend we are able to celebrate Sunday Mass together. Two weeks ago there were about 100 people on all weekend Masses. A week ago about 150.

The 9.00am Mass was the busiest and not everyone could enter the church as we reached the maximum number of people. There were some spaces on Saturday Vigil Mass at 6.00pm and many spaces at 11.00am on Sunday.

At this time we normally had registrations for the First Communion and Confirmation Programs. There is no registrations at the moment. We hope to resume last year programs in September and possibly have the First Holy Communion and Confirmation in October.

Celebration of Mass at St Peter's Dagenham (up to 70 people per Mass)

- 1. The obligation to attend Sunday Mass remains suspended. Please stay at home if you or someone you live with starts to show symptoms: a high temperature, a new, continuous cough, a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste or you have been in contact with someone who has the virus.
- 2. Children under 16 years should be accompanied by their parent or other responsible adult.
- 3. As you enter and leave the church please **sanitise your hands**. Alcohol hand gel is provided at doors. The toilets will not be available.
- 4. **Do not forget your face mask** or other face covering as they are compulsory as 2 metre distancing is reduced to 1 metre + from each other.
- 5. Members of the same household can sit together.
- 6. There will be no singing, no offertory procession, no bidding prayers, no offertory collection and no exchanging of the sign of peace during the Mass. For donations there will be baskets available at the exits.
- 7. Holy Communion will be distributed only under one kind (i.e. the Host). You will only be able to receive Holy Communion on the hand. When you receive Holy Communion **do not say** 'Amen' aloud. It is vital that you follow the guidance of the Stewards who will direct you.
- 8. At the moment no altar servers (except of the Master of Ceremony) will be needed.
- 9. Toilets will remain closed.
- 10. When mass has ended, please leave the church so the cleaners can begin the cleaning. Please respect the social distancing requirements before and after mass.
