

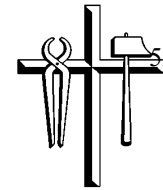

Readings: p.95 Response: *Psalm 22*

The Lord is my shepherd, there is nothing I shall want.



What does the separation of goats and sheep have to do with the Day of God's Judgement over the earth? Goats by temperament are aggressive, domineering, restless, and territorial. They butt heads with their horns whenever they think someone is intruding on their space. Goats came to symbolize evil and the expression "scape-goat" became a common expression for someone bearing blame or guilt for others. Jesus took our guilt and sins upon himself and nailed them to the cross. He payed the price to set us free from sin and death. Our choice is either to follow and obey him as our Lord and Saviour or to be our own master and go our own separate way apart from God's way of truth and righteousness (moral goodness). We cannot remain neutral or indifferent to the commands of Christ. If we do not repent of

our wrongdoing (our sins and offenses against God and neighbour) and obey the Gospel we cannot be disciples of the Lord Jesus nor inherit his kingdom of righteousness, peace, and joy. Separation of the good from the bad is inevitable because one way leads to sin, rebellion, and death and the other way leads to purification, peace, and everlasting life with God. servantsoftheword.org
