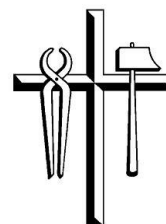

*Resp. Psalm: Give thanks to the Lord for he is good, for his love has no end.*

\*\*\*\*\*ADVANCE NOTICES\*\*\*\*\*

**For prospective applicants for First Holy Communion and Confirmation –** Applicants must be practising Catholic and regularly attending mass for at least 6 months before programme begins. Registrations for these preparation programmes will be available from the beginning of June.

**The R.C.I.A The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)** is the process through in which adults wishing to become Roman Catholics (or adult Roman Catholics wishing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation) are gradually introduced to the Catholic faith and way of life. Please contact Fr Edward for more details.

**Sacrament of Matrimony / Convalidation of Marriage** At least six months’ notice of the date on which you hope to marry, must be given to the priest of the parish. Please contact Fr Edward for more details.

**Infant/ child Baptism.** At least one parent must be practicing Catholic. Children age 7 and older must accomplish a special preparation programme before baptism. Please see Fr Edward for more details.

**Secondary School Forms** Children who wish to continue education in a Catholic Secondary School usually need the priest’s signature confirming that they are practising Catholics. To obtain one they need to come to Church regularly and present the Baptism Certificate and First Communion Certificate.
