**RE-OPENING OF ST PETER'S CHURCH (For private prayer only)**  
**Monday-Friday 9.00am -10.30am,**  
**From Saturday, 4<sup>th</sup> July – Please check our website.**

**When visiting the church please remember:**

1. The guidance only allows personal prayer which is defined as a person or household entering the church to pray on their own and not as part of a group.
- 2 Social distancing must apply at all times with people being two metres apart from one another in all directions.
3. The entry and exit will be via separate doors and some benches will be blocked off to facilitate this.
4. At least two stewards will be present in the church throughout the time it is open for prayer.
5. Alcohol hand gel will be provided at doors. Please sanitise your hands as you enter and leave the church.
6. Toilet facilities will remain closed.

We will find more details as you enter the church

We need voluntaries to help as stewards when the church is open and also more people to help with daily cleaning of the church. Only with your help we will be able to keep the church open. We cannot accept help from those who have been advised to shield or are from groups considered more vulnerable to the virus. Volunteers who live with someone who is shielding should carefully consider the additional risk they incur.

Message from Fr Edward.

“You are Peter and on this rock I will build my Church. And the gates of underworld can never hold out against it.” These are words from the Gospel reading for the Solemnity of St Peter and Paul. Everyone visiting our parish church can see their Latin version written on the interior walls of the building. Jesus said them after Peter's confession: “You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God”. This year, the liturgical celebration of that feast has been moved from Monday 29<sup>th</sup> of June to Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> of June. St Peter is a Holy Patron of our Church and our Parish. Hopefully this will be last Sunday when Mass is celebrated without the congregation.

Next week the church will be open for private prayer only up to Friday.

On Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> July we plan to restart saying Masses and 40-70 people should be able to attend them. This will not be return to normal, just the first step. There will be restrictions and changes due to the social distancing and health and safety regulations. If we decide to allow more people in the church you will be asked to cover your face with mask. Please be prepared for this. We can't guarantee access to the church. In the coming days we will try to find the best solutions. Also from Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> July there will be possibly to go to confession.
