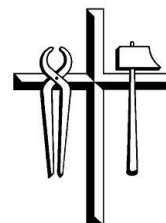

Pg. 105 R Psalm: From all my terrors the Lord set me free. Or: The angel of the Lord rescues those who revere him.



Through faith Peter grasped who Jesus truly was. He was the first apostle to proclaim that Jesus was truly the *Anointed One (Messiah and Christ)* and the *only begotten Son of God*. The New Testament describes the church, the people of God, as a spiritual house and temple of the Holy Spirit with each member joined together as *living*. Faith in Jesus Christ makes us into *rocks - spiritual stones*. The Lord Jesus tests each of us personally with the same question: *Who do you say that I am?*
