GUIDANCE REGARDING COMMUNAL WORSHIP

Managing COVID-19 in Step 4. From Monday 19 July many of the legal restrictions around measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19 has been lifted in England. This doesn’t mean that coronavirus has gone away. We will have to continue to manage the risk for ourselves and others.

We can safely accommodate approximately 200 people at each Mass.

After reaching this number we may need to lock the church doors (Sunday, 9.00am and 11.00am). To avoid disappointment please allow some time before mass starts when arriving.

Please continue to sanitise your hands and wear face coverings in the church.

- Please use the Government Track & Trace system using the QR code on display in the Church or complete the form provided.
- Singing is now permitted but it should be phased in gently and face covering should be worn by members of congregation whilst singing together.
- Physical Sign of Peace remains suspended
- **Holy Communion** will continue to be under one kind (Bread).
- The container with **Holy Water** is at its usual place near the entry to the Sacristy. Please bring your own empty bottle.
