LATEST GUIDANCE REGARDING COMMUNAL WORSHIP

- You must follow the guidance on the safe use of places of worship and you must not mingle with anyone outside of your household or support bubble when attending a place of worship.
- DO NOT attend the Church if you or someone you live with starts to show symptoms: a high temperature, a new, continuous cough, a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste or you have been in contact with someone who has the virus. Please hand sanitise upon entering and leaving the Church.
- Always wear a face covering. It must cover both your mouth and nose at all times, except for the consumption of Holy Communion.
- Please keep social distance at all times when in the Church.
- During Mass you are not allowed to join singing, there is no offertory collection and procession, we receive Body of Christ only.
- As there is no collection during Mass, you can put your donation to the boxes or basket by the exit doors. Toilet facilities will remain closed.
