**Celebration of Mass at St Peter’s Dagenham (up to 95 people per Mass)**

1. Limits on the number of people you can see socially have changed. When meeting friends and family you do not live with (or have formed a support bubble with) you must not meet in a group of more than 6, indoors or outdoors.
2. Please stay at home if you or someone you live with starts to show symptoms: a high temperature, a new, continuous cough, a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste or you have been in contact with someone who has the virus.
3. As you enter and leave the church please **sanitise your hands**. Alcohol hand gel is provided at doors. **The toilets will not be available.**
4. **Do not forget your face mask** (Aged 11 +) or other face covering as they are compulsory as 2 metre distancing is reduced to 1 metre + from each other.

**Test & Trace** To support the NHS Test and Trace programme, we are asking for contact details of Mass attendees, as well as recording times of attendance. **This is to be completed for every mass you attend.**

In line with official guidance, we will keep your details safely and in compliance with GDPR legislation for 21 days before securely disposing of them. We will only share your details with NHS Test and Trace, if asked.
