Gospel Acc. Alleluia, alleluia! I give you a new commandment: love one another, just as I have loved you, says the Lord. Alleluia!

First Holy Communion, Confirmation, RCIA 2019. We are unable to foresee any dates to celebrate either groups. We will be keeping you updated as we receive any guidance from the Diocese.

We have added an additional mass. Every Sunday at 12.30pm. This is to allow more parishioners to celebrate mass safely. Please be sure to arrive early to masses. Please encourage children and young people from our First Holy Communion and Confirmation groups to come. They can attend any of the masses.

Celebration of Mass at St Peter’s Dagenham (up to 80 people per Mass)

1. Worshippers should limit their interactions with anyone they are not attending church with, i.e. if they are attending corporate worship with one other household, wherever possible they should maintain social distancing with anyone outside of this group.
2. Please stay at home if you or someone you live with starts to show symptoms: a high temperature, a new, continuous cough, a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste or you have been in contact with someone who has the virus.
3. As you enter and leave the church please **sanitise your hands**. Alcohol hand gel is provided at doors. **The toilets will not be available.**
4. **Do not forget your face mask** or other face covering as they are compulsory as 2 metre distancing is reduced to 1 metre + from each other. Face masks/coverings must be worn by those aged 11 years and older.
5. Members of the same household can sit together.
6. There will be no singing, no offertory procession, no bidding prayers, no offertory collection and no exchanging of the sign of peace during the Mass. For donations there will be baskets available at the exits.
7. Holy Communion will be distributed only under one kind (i.e. the Host). You will only be able to receive Holy Communion on the hand. When you receive Holy Communion **do not say** ‘Amen’ aloud. It is vital that you follow the guidance of the Stewards who will direct you.
8. At the moment no altar servers (except of the Master of Ceremony) will be needed.
9. When mass has ended, please leave the church so the cleaners can begin the cleaning. Please respect the social distancing requirements before and after mass.
