Registration forms for Confirmation 2025 are available now. They need to be completed and returned by Sunday 14th of July. Candidates must be at least 14 years old in September 2024 and attend Sunday Mass at St Peter’s regularly for at **least 3 months** before classes begin.

The R.C.I.A. The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process through in which adults wishing to become Roman Catholics (or adult Roman Catholics wishing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation) are gradually introduced to the Catholic faith and way of life.
