ADVANCE NOTICE for prospective applicants for First Holy

Communion and Confirmation Classes –applicants must be practising Catholic and regularly attending mass for at least 6 months before programme begins. Registrations for these preparation programmes will be available from the beginning of June.

The R.C.I.A The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process through in which adults wishing to become Roman Catholics (or adult Roman Catholics wishing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation) are gradually introduced to the Catholic faith and way of life.
