October Month of the Rosary The month of October each year is dedicated to the Most Holy Rosary. The purpose of the Rosary is to help keep in memory certain principal events in the history of our salvation. Every Sunday in October, we will pray a decade of the rosary **after 9am mass**. Please encourage candidates preparing for First Holy Communion and Confirmation to come together to learn and pray. Rosary beads are available for sale in our repository.

Primary School Children in Year 6.
