**Celebration of Mass at St Peter’s Dagenham (up to 95 people per Mass)**

- Tier 2 Restrictions- High.** From this Saturday, the government restrictions includes no mixing with other households. Please be considerate to others and leave the church with your household avoiding close contact with others. The rule of 6 now applies only to outdoors.
