LATEST GUIDANCE REGARDING COMMUNAL WORSHIP

You are allowed to leave home to attend or visit a place of worship for communal worship.

You must follow the guidance on the safe use of places of worship and you must not mingle with anyone outside of your household or support bubble when attending a place of worship.

The celebration of Mass can continue however: DO NOT attend the Church if you or someone you live with starts to show symptoms: a high temperature, a new, continuous cough, a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste or you have been in contact with someone who has the virus.
