LATEST GUIDANCE REGARDING COMMUNAL WORSHIP

PLEASE DO NOT attend the Church if you or someone you live with starts to show symptoms: a high temperature, a new, continuous cough, a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste or you have been in contact with someone who has the virus. Please hand sanitise upon entering and leaving the Church.

- You must follow the guidance on the safe use of places of worship and you must not mingle with anyone outside of your household or support bubble when attending a place of worship.
- Always wear a face covering. Please keep social distance at all times when in the Church.
- Please use the Government Track & Trace system using the QR code on display in the Church or complete the form provided.
- It must cover both your mouth and nose at all times, except for the consumption of Holy Communion.
- During Mass you are not allowed to join singing, there is no offertory collection and procession, we receive Body of Christ only. As there is no collection during Mass, you can put your donation to the boxes or basket by the exit doors. Toilet facilities will remain closed.
