# Celebration of Mass at St Peter's Dagenham from Wednesday, 2<sup>nd</sup> December (up to 95 people per Mass)

- 1. **Tier 2 Restrictions- High.** The government restrictions includes no mixing with other households. Please be considerate to others and leave the church with your household avoiding close contact with others. The rule of 6 applies only to outdoors.
- 2. Please stay at home if you or someone you live with starts to show symptoms: a high temperature, a new, continuous cough, a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste or you have been in contact with someone who has the virus.
- 3. As you enter and leave the church please **sanitise your hands**. Alcohol hand gel is provided at doors. **The toilets will not be available.**
- 4. **Do not forget your face mask** (Aged 11 +) or other face covering as they are compulsory as 2 metre distancing is reduced to 1 metre + from each other.
