**NEW SOUND SYSTEM FOR CHURCH - UPDATE:** We have received couple of quotations so far. However, the cost of the project is higher than expected. If we want to have the whole sound system changed, we need to think about a project over £20000. If we only change the main core of the sound system including all the microphones (no speakers), the cost will be around £14000. Nevertheless, if we go for the second option the final effect of the project may not be as good as expected. At the moment we are waiting for one more quotation to make the final decision.
