NEW ENVELOPES & GIFT AID SCHEME (EXPLAINED): The Gift Aid scheme remains an important way of increasing your offertory collection. It is available to **all UK taxpayers**. You are not required to give a specific amount every week but, whatever you give through donations, Sunday offertory collections, Mass intentions, etc. will be increased by the Government by 25% at no extra cost to you. If you are not on the scheme and would like to be part of it all you need to do is to complete and sign the Gift Aid declaration form. To do so speak to Sally or contact the Parish Office, please.
