ADVANCE NOTICE for prospective applicants for **First Holy Communion and Confirmation Classes 2024/25** –applicants must be practising Catholic and regularly attending mass for at least 6 months before classes begin. Registrations forms for these programmes will be available in June. Please check our Newsletter and website regularly for the exact date.

RCIA. The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process through in which adults wishing to become Roman Catholics (or adult Roman Catholics wishing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation) are gradually introduced to the Catholic faith and way of life. Please contact Fr Edward for more details

Catholic School Forms. Those who need the Certificate of Catholic Practice please see Fr Edward during our parish office hours. You should be known to the priest to be a practising catholic. For Primary school places, please bring child’s Baptism certificate, for Secondary school bring First Communion Certificate. If you do not practise your faith, please apply under another criteria.

Sacrament of Matrimony / Convalidation of Marriage. At least six months’ notice of the date on which you hope to marry, must be given to the priest of the parish.

Infant/ child Baptism. At least one parent must be practicing catholic. Children age 7 and older must accomplish a special preparation programme before baptism. Please see Fr Edward for more details.
