THE MOST HOLY TRINITY (B)

1st Reading: Deuteronomy 4; 32-34. 39-40 **Second Reading:** Romans 8:14-17,

Psalm: **Happy the people the Lord has chosen as his own.**

Gospel: Matthew 28:16-20



How can we personally know the Father and his Son, our Lord Jesus Christ? It is the Holy Spirit who reveals the Father and the Son to us and who gives us the gift of faith to know and understand the truth of God's word. Through the Holy Spirit, we proclaim our ancient faith in the saving death and resurrection of Jesus Christ until he comes again. The Lord gives us his Holy Spirit as our divine Teacher and Helper that we may grow in the knowledge and wisdom of God... Jesus' last words to his apostles point to his saving mission and to their mission to be witnesses of his saving death

and his glorious resurrection and to proclaim the good news of salvation to all the world. Their task is to proclaim the "good news" of salvation, not only to the people of Israel, but to all the nations. God's love and gift of salvation is not just for a few, or for a nation, but it is for the whole world - for all who will accept it. The Gospel (the *Good News* of Jesus Christ) is the power of God, the power to forgive sins, to heal, to deliver from evil and oppression, and to restore life.
