UPDATING CHURCH REGISTER AND WELCOMING NEW PARISHIONERS: We are in the process of updating our Parish records. If you are new to the parish or did not complete *Parish Census Information Form* in the past you may do it now. Special *Parish Census Information Forms* are available from the porch.

NEW ENVELOPES & GIFT AID SCHEME (EXPLAINED): The Gift Aid scheme remains an important way of increasing your offertory collection. It is available to **all UK taxpayers**. You are not required to give a specific amount every week but, whatever you give through donations, Sunday offertory collections, Mass intentions, etc. will be increased by the Government by 25% at no extra cost to you.

- If you are already on the scheme your new Gift Aid Envelopes 2025/2026 should be ready for collection;
- If you cannot find your envelopes this means you may need to sign a new declaration;
- If you are not on the scheme and would like to be part of it all you need to do is to complete and sign the Gift Aid declaration form.
