3. fulfill the Required Conditions:
 - be in a state of grace (free from mortal sin);
 - have the intention to gain the indulgence;
 - receive Holy Communion;
 - pray for the intentions of the Holy Father (Our Father and Hail Mary)

This practice is a powerful act of mercy that helps release souls undergoing purification and bring them closer to Heaven. It reflects the Church's teaching on the communion of Saints and the importance of prayer for the Deceased.

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GIFT AID SCHEME (EXPLAINED): The *Gift Aid scheme* remains an important way of increasing your offertory collection. It is available to **all UK taxpayers**. You are not required to give a specific amount every week but, whatever you give through donations, Sunday offertory collections, Mass intentions, etc. will be increased by the Government by 25% at no extra cost to you.
